



No Smoking signs

Since 1 July 2007, virtually all enclosed public places, workplaces and vehicles in the UK have become smoke-free and No smoking signs must be displayed.

No-smoking signs in smoke free premise

No-smoking signs must be displayed in a prominent position at every entrance to smoke free premises.

Signs must meet the following minimum requirements:

- a. be a minimum of A5 in area (210mm x 148mm),
- b. display the international no-smoking symbol, which consists solely of a graphic representation of a single burning cigarette enclosed in a red circle of at least 70mm in diameter with a red bar across it, and
- c. carry the following words in characters that can be easily read:

"No smoking. It is against the law to smoke in these premises".

No-smoking signs in smoke free vehicles

Smoke free vehicles must display a no-smoking sign in each compartment of the vehicle in which people can be carried. These no-smoking signs must display the international no-smoking symbol at least 70mm in diameter.
